


UK Innovation Survey 2021:Northern Ireland Results



The UK Innovation Survey (UKIS) provides a wide range of information related to innovation activity among enterprises, and includes information on the extent of innovation activity, the impact of innovation on business and the barriers to innovation. This report presents results from the Northern Ireland (NI) element covering the three year period from 2018 to 2020.

Innovation by Size of Enterprise







Factors Driving Innovation




The least cited driver was entering new markets (17% for NI & 18% for UK).


Reasons for No Innovation Activity
